

Call to boycott Aadhaar

HYDERABAD: A meeting of three NGOs here on Saturday demanded scrapping of Aadhaar project as it was becoming a backdoor method to connect to public services as cooking gas.

The demand was made in the form of Hyderabad declaration of the NGOs – Deccan Development Society (DDC), National Alliance of People's Movements (NAPM) and Human Rights Law Network (HRLN).

Briefing reporters about the outcome of the meeting, P.V. Satheesh of DDC, Saraswati Kavula of NAPM and Shakeel Mohammed of HRLN said the speakers highlighted how the unique identification numbers and Aadhaar had been projected as voluntary but turned out to be compulsory.
